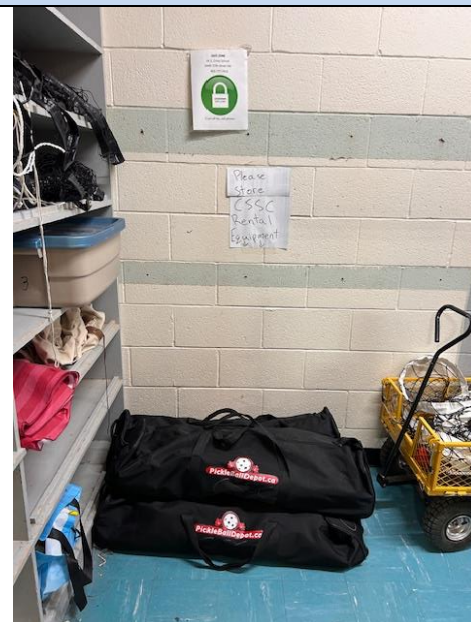

General Information

Parking: Players can use the school parking lot located on the North West side of the school.

Entrance: Players should enter through the main doors of the school located on the East side of the school.

Gym Location: After entering the school through the main entrance, the gym is located immediately to the right.

Change room/Washroom: There are washrooms/change rooms located in the main hallway just outside the gym.

Equipment

Sport Specific Equipment Location and details:

Postholes: Use the post holes located approximately 1.5 feet outside of the court lines.

Posts: There are 5 blue Badminton posts located in the equipment room within the gym (equipment room is on the west wall of the gym). 2 of the posts have pulleys and cranks.

Nets: The school owns the nets. They are located in the gym equipment room on the shelf immediately to the left when you walk in. There are 4 nets total and are connected in pairs. Please DO NOT disconnect any of the nets.

Court Lines: 4 courts – Green all around.

Gym Set-up

Badminton

Step 1: Put the 2 posts with the pulleys/cranks in the post holes on the outside of the 4 courts.

Step 2: Place the remaining 3 posts in the post holes in between the pulley/crank posts.

Step 3: Grab one set of attached nets and attach the end with rope up through the pulley and secure it. Put the other end of the rope through the second post, then attach the carabiner to the hook on the middle post.

Step 4: Tighten the rope on the pulley. DO NOT OVER-TIGHTEN.

Step 5: Repeat for the other 2 connected net

Pickleball

There are four official Pickleball nets in the same area as the other nets. They are stored in black bags with the poles, nets and instructions. When you open the bag, set up directions are laminated inside.

PLEASE ENSURE EVERYTHING GOES BACK INTO THE BAG AND BACK IN THE EQUIPMENT ROOM BY AT THE END OF THE NIGHT
