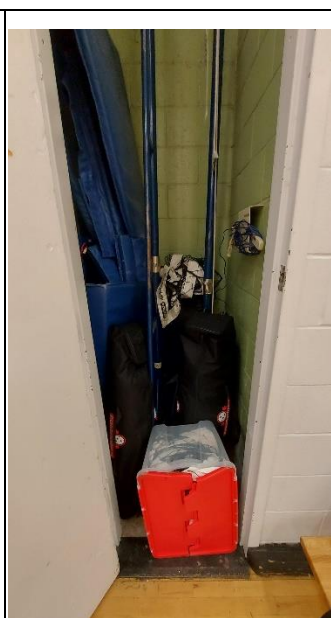

## General Information

**Parking:** Players may park in the main lot on the east side of the building.

**Entrance:** Players may use the main entrance on the east side of the school.

**Gym Location:** The gym will be located on the left upon entering through the main doors.

**Change room/Washroom:** The male change room is located outside the gym by the main entrance of the school. To get to the female change room, continue straight down the long hallway after entering through the main entrance. At the end of the hallway, turn left and the female change room is located on the left side wall.

## Equipment

### Sport Specific Equipment Location and details:

**Posts:** Use the 4 blue posts. They are kept in the gym divider closet. **PLEASE ONLY USE EQUIPMENT IN GYM DIVIDER CLOSET.**

**PLEASE NOTE:** On two of the posts, there is tape that says **"DO NOT USE"**. Simply turn the post and use the crank on the other side. These posts do not have supports on the bottom, but they are good to use.

**Postholes:** Use the post holes that are 1.5 feet from the walls and ~2 feet from the blue sidelines.

**Nets:** The CSSC owns the nets, there should be two nets, model VN8080. They are kept in a beige bin and stored in the gym's divider closet.

**Court Lines:** Red all around except for the middle sideline, which is blue.

## Gym Set-up

### Volleyball

**PLEASE ONLY USE EQUIPMENT IN GYM DIVIDER CLOSET.**

**Step 1:** Choose one post that cranks the net on the bottom and one that cranks the net on the top for each court.

**Step 2:** The net height is adjustable on each post – set it to the 2<sup>nd</sup> hole from the top.

**Step 3:** Each net has a cable loop on all 4 corners. Attach the top of one corner of the net to the S-hook on the top of the post and the other top corner to the S-hook on the rope or strap.

**Step 4:** Repeat for the bottom of the net, but the rope/strap and crank will be on the opposite side.

**Step 5:** Tighten the net on the top and bottom using the crank wheel. DO NOT OVER-TIGHTEN.

### Pickleball

The CSSC owns the pickleball nets.

These are also stored in the divider closet. Please be careful when storing and removing anything from this closet, as it is tight for space.

## Important Notes

- Please be sure to only use the equipment found in the gym divider closet. Equipment found in other areas may not fit the posts correctly and has not been approved for our group to use.
- Put away equipment with care. The closet is a tight space, but everything will fit.
