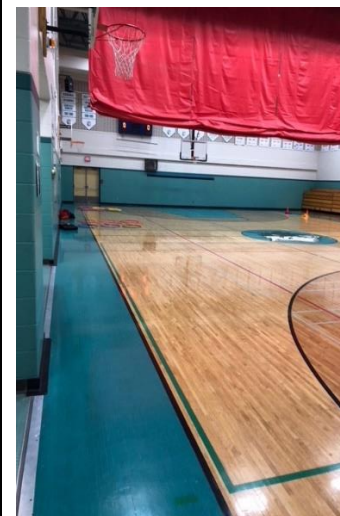

## General Information

**Parking:** Utilize the main parking lot located at the south end of the building.

**Entrance:** Enter through the school's main doors that are located on the south side of the building.

**Gym Location:** The main gym is located slightly to the left as you enter the school. There is a large sign that says "Main Gym".

**Change room/Washroom:** Use the washrooms / change rooms located inside the gym.

**Floor:** The gym floor is made of wood. Please wear non-marking shoes when using the gym, leave all outdoor footwear outside of the gym.

## Equipment

### Sport Specific Equipment Location and details:

**Equipment Room:** Located on the far wall halfway along the wall through a set of double doors.

### Volleyball

**Postholes:** Postholes are located closest to the court lines (green).

**IMPORTANT:** It has been noted that some of the post hole sleeves may not be working properly, causing the posts to lean inward when nets are tight. Until the school fixes this, please prop the posthole covers under the base of the post to provide proper support. This will stop the nets from sagging when tightened.

**Posts:** There are 7 functional posts located at the school and are high school caliber. For this set-up, you will need 1 post that cranks at the bottom and 1 post that cranks at the top for each court. The height of the nets is adjustable.

**Nets:** The nets are owned by the school and kept in the storage room. They are hanging up on the wall near the posts. Please ensure they are hung back up at the end of the night.

**Court lines:** Green all around



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## Gym Set-up

### Volleyball

**Step 1:** For the first court set-up, choose one post that will crank the top of the net and one post that will crank the bottom of the net. Place each post into the correct postholes next to the court (see above).

**Step 2:** Attach the loop on the top corner of the net to the S-hook on the post. Do the same on the other side of the net.

**Step 3:** Attach the bottom loop of the net to the S-hook on the post. Do the same on the other side of the net.

**Step 4:** Tighten both cranks until net is tight. DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN

**Step 5:** Repeat steps for the second court.

### Basketball

**Court Lines:** Black all around

## Important Notes

- Please ensure the posts and nets are put back in the proper location at the end of the night (see photos above). The nets should be hung up on the wall as shown and posts returned to the holes in the floor.
