

<b>School:</b>	<b>DOUGLAS HARKNESS</b>
<b>Last Updated:</b>	<b>February 8<sup>th</sup>, 2016 (BC)</b>
<b>General Info:</b>	Use the main entrance. The gym is to the right as you enter the school.
<b>Court Lines:</b>	There are 2 smaller courts (25' wide). Use the two outside courts with red end lines and yellow sidelines.
<b>Post holes:</b>	Use the post holes that are located 6 inches outside the courts.
<b>Nets:</b>	The CSSC owns the nets. They are good caliber with cable on the top and bottom. The nets are model TVN200 and say "Property of the CSSC" on them. They are stored in a small plastic bin labeled "CSSC Volleyball" on the top shelf of the gym storage room.
<b>Posts:</b>	The posts are kept in the gym storage room. There are 8 total. Use the 4 posts that have cranks and ropes on them. The 4 posts we use have white tape on them and are numbered 1-4. Post 1 and 4 have to be used on the ends against the walls because the base is smaller. Post 1 and 4 crank high, posts 2 and 3 crank low. The posts that crank low will have s-hooks on the bottom rope and s-hooks on the top of the post. The two posts that crank high will have s-hooks on the top rope and an s-hook on the bottom d-ring.
<b>Step 1</b>	Use the posts numbered 1 and 2 for one court, and posts 3 and 4 for the other court. Post 1 needs to go against the end wall because of the smaller base on one court, and post 4 will go against the wall on the other court.
<b>Step 2</b>	Each net has a cable loop on all 4 corners. Attach the top of one corner of the net to the s-hook on the top of the post and the other top corner to the s-hook on the rope going down to the crank.
<b>Step 3</b>	Attach the bottom corner of the net to the s-hook on the lower d-ring on the top cranking post and attach the net to the s-hook on the rope going to the crank on the other post.
<b>Step 4</b>	Tighten the net on the top and bottom using the crank wheel. DO NOT over-tighten.
<b>Step 5</b>	Repeat for the other court.
