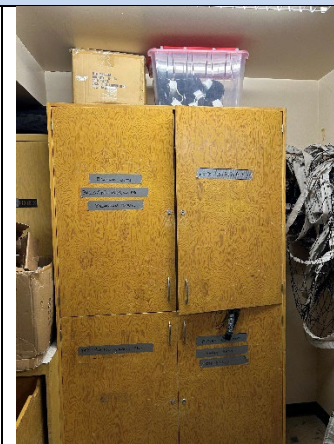

General Information

Parking: Players may **NOT** park in any reserved parking stall **AT ANY TIME**. Players can park in the lot on the east side of the building.

Entrance: Players should enter from the main entrance on the north side of the building. Players should leave outdoor footwear at the entrance.

Gym Location: Utilize the main entrance, turn right as you enter the school, and the gym will be at the end of the hallway.

Change room/Washroom: Two options, beside library, or staff washroom immediately outside gym entrance.

Floor: Wood Floor

Sport Specific Equipment Location and details:

Volleyball Posts: There are 4 posts located under the stage in the third drawer from the right All the posts are High School caliber posts. Ensure you are pairing posts with one crank on top, and one on the bottom.

Volleyball Nets: The school owns the nets. They are kept in the cupboard '8D' in the gym storage room or along the wall beside the cupboard They are cable top and bottom with clips or S-hooks on all corners.

Volleyball Court Lines: The lines are yellow all around.

Volleyball Postholes: Use the postholes that are `3 feet outside each court.

Badminton Posts: There are 8 badminton posts located in the back of the equipment room located in the SW corner of the gym. You will need assistance from a facility operator to gain access to the room.

Badminton Nets: The CSSC owns the nets. There are 6 nets in a bin on top of the cupboard in the storage room. Right by the volleyball nets.

Badminton Court Lines: There are 6 courts, all outlined in grey.

Gym Set-up

Volleyball

Step 1: Choose one post that cranks on the bottom of the net and one that cranks on the top of the net for each court.

Step 2: The net height is adjustable on each post – set it to the 2nd hole from the top.

Step 3: Each net has a loop on all 4 corners. Attach the top of one corner of the net to the s-hook on the top of the post and the other top corner to the s-hook on the rope.

Step 4: Repeat for the bottom of the net, but the rope and crank will be on the opposite side.

Step 5: Tighten the net on the top and bottom using the crank wheel. Do NOT over-tighten.

Badminton

Step 1: There are 8, blue badminton posts in the storage room. There are four end posts (have D rings on one side) and four middle posts (have D rings on both sides).

Step 2: Place end posts into the two end post holes, and place middle posts into the two middle post holes.

Step 3: Get Badminton nets from the CSSC bin in the equipment room. The nets are not specific to what courts they should be placed on. Attach nets to posts by looping the rope through the top ring of each post, and then tie a simple knot to secure.

Step 4: To achieve desired tension, twist the end posts to tighten the nets separately.

Important Notes

- Do not prop open the exit doors.
