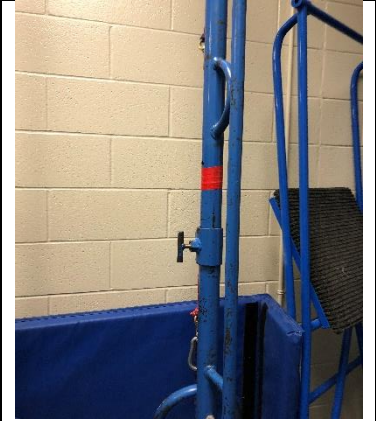

General Information

Parking: Players may use the school parking lot for parking.

Entrance: Players should enter from the main entrance on the West side of the building. Players should leave outdoor footwear at the door (especially during the winter months).

Gym Location: When you enter the school, turn left down the hallway. At the end, you will see the gym doors.

Change room/Washroom: Washrooms are located in the hallway to the right of the gym doors. Please do not wander the halls

Equipment

Sport Specific Equipment Location and details:

Postholes: Use the post holes located ~ 3 feet outside of the courts.

Posts: The Volleyball posts are located in the room next to the stage in the gym. This door should not be locked, and is to the left of the double doors equipment room, which you will not need access to. There are 4 High School caliber posts. All the posts have s-hooks or clips. One of the light blue poles (Red Tape) has to go next to the stage during setup because of the base. The other light blue post (Silver tape) has to go against the wall on the other end of the gym. The 2 darker blue posts (Blue/Green tape) go in the middle two postholes.

PLEASE ENSURE POSTS ARE PUT BACK IN PROPER LOCATION IN THE EQUIPMENT ROOM (Wooden boxes – each labeled to specific posts).

Nets: The school owns the nets. There are 2 High School quality nets with cable on top and bottoms. The nets are located in the storage room next to the stage hanging on the wall. Each net has a piece of tape (Red, Blue, Green, or Silver) which corresponds to the post they should be attached to (see pictures). PLEASE HANG NETS BACK UP ON THE WALL AT THE END OF THE NIGHT.

Court Lines: Yellow sidelines and red end line (please keep in mind the red line is very close to the wall; however, to maintain proper court dimensions, the back red line should be used during gameplay).

Serving: one end of the court closest to the stage has a basketball net and chin up bar hanging above. Please move to the side to serve. Alternatively, take one step forward.

Gym Set-up

Volleyball

Step 1: Each post has a piece of colored tape wrapped around it. These colors correspond with the specific base they need to be stored on in the equipment room. The colored tape is also used to correspond with which post holes the posts go in (there are sheets of paper hanging up on the wall in the gym to indicate proper spots – see above for photos).

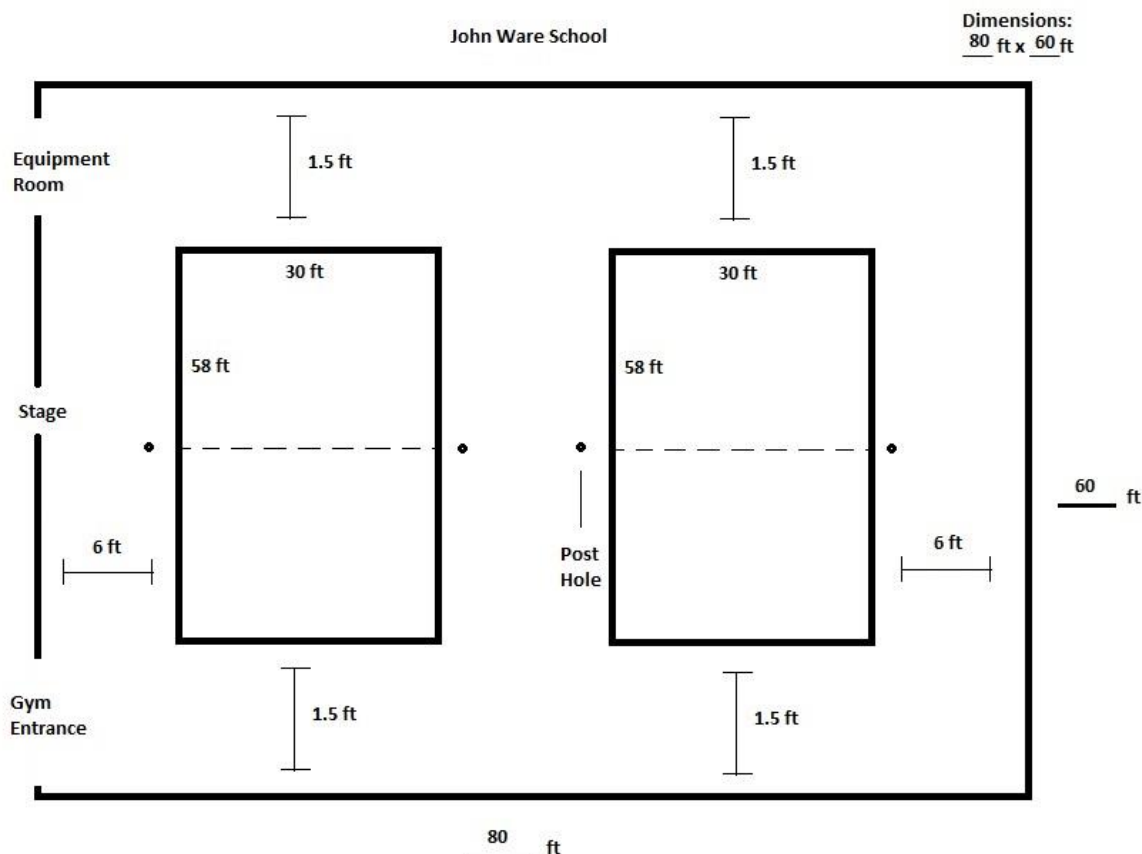
Step 2: On each court, one post will crank from the bottom and the other will tighten from the top.

Step 3: The net height is adjustable on each post – set it to the 2nd hole from the top.

Step 4: Each net has a loop on all 4 corners as well as a piece of coloured tape along the side. Match the colour tape to the proper post. Attach the top of one corner of the net to the s-hook on the top of the post and the other top corner to the s-hook on the rope.

Step 5: Repeat for the bottom of the net, but the rope and crank will be on the opposite side. Tighten the net on the top and bottom using the crank wheel. Do NOT over-tighten.
