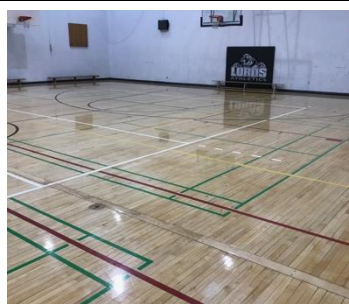

General Information

Parking: Players may **NOT** park in any reserved parking stall **AT ANY TIME**. Players can park in the lot on the East side of the school. Players should not park in the lots on the West side of the school as they are staff lots and parking for the pool.

Entrance: Players should enter from the main entrance on the South side of the building. Players should remove all outdoor footwear at the entrance.

Gym Location: Through the main entrance, continue down the hallway and the aux gym will be the second and smaller gym on the right past the main gym.

Change room/Washroom: Around the corner from the Aux gym in the hallway between the Main Gym and the Aux Gym

Sport Specific Equipment Location and details:

Volleyball:

Nets: The school owns the nets. They usually live on the bleachers on either side of the gym, if not they will be hanging on the walls on either side of the gym entrance.

Posts: They have 4 blue posts that are high school caliber. They each have a crank wheel with a rope and the metal sleeves can be moved to adjust the net height. They are stored in the corner of the gym behind the bleachers.

Gym Set-up

Basketball

Court Lines: Basketball court uses thick black out of bounds and court lines

Volleyball

Step 1: Choose one post that cranks on the bottom and one that cranks on the top for each court.

Step 2: Adjust the net height to the 2nd hole from the top.

Step 3: On the corner of each net there is either a loop on the end of the cable, or a chain with an s-hook. Attach the loop on the top corner of the net to the s-hook on the rope and then attaché the chain to the s-hook on the top of the opposite post.

Step 4: If you attach the END of the chain to the post, you may not be able to crank the top of the net tight because you have too much slack – you may have to attach the chain to the post only a few links from the corner of the net, so that the net pulls tight.
