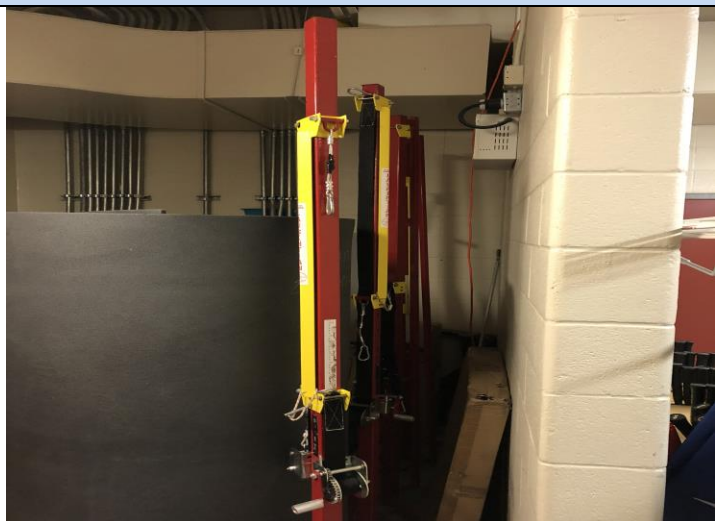

General Information

Parking: Players may park on the street or in the school parking lot.

Entrance: Players can enter the school through the main entrance at the front of the school.

Gym Location: When entering the school through the main entrance, turn right down the first hallway, then the gym will be located on the left side beyond the cafeteria area.

Change room/Washroom: There are washrooms available just past the main office when you turn right to head toward the gym.

Floor: Wood floor

Equipment

Sport Specific Equipment Location and details:

Posts: Use the 4 red HS caliber posts located in the gym storage room with straps attached to them. 2 of the posts have a solid base with wheels, while the other 2 posts have no supporting base. The two posts without a base need to be in the two centre holes in the gym, while the two posts with a supporting base need to be on the outside of the courts, at either end of the gym. Middle posts must be tethered together to add support.

Post Holes: Use the post holes that are approximately 3.5 – 4 feet outside each court

Nets: The CSSC owns the nets and they are stored in a box on the shelf in the equipment room. Our nets say "Property of CSSC" on them and are labeled 'SCORE FVJ VN200 – 32'.

Court Lines: Lines are red on the end lines, yellow on the sidelines closest to the middle of the gym, and green on the sidelines closest to the outside of the gym.

Gym Set-up

Volleyball

Step 1: For each court, select one post that has a supporting base and place it in the post hole on the outside of the court, closest to the end wall. The second post for each court does not have a supporting base. Place these posts in the inner post holes, in the middle of the gym.

Step 2: Both of the middle posts that do not have supporting bases have straps on both sides. These will be used on each court.
