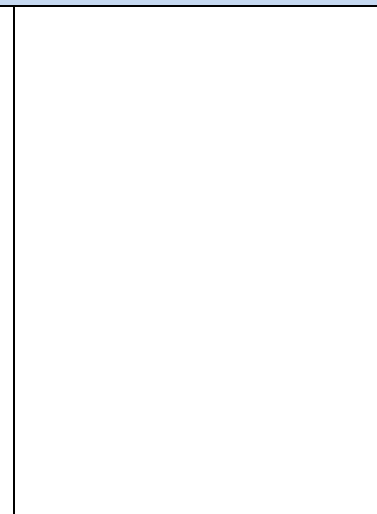
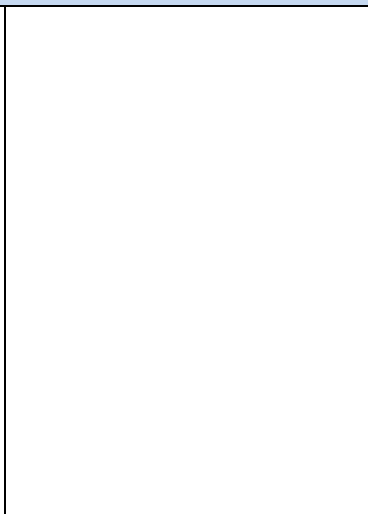

General Information

Parking: Players may **NOT** park in any reserved parking stall **AT ANY TIME**. Players can park in the main lot on the North end of the school off Lake Lucerne Drive.

Entrance: Players should enter from the main entrance on the West side of the building. Players should leave outdoor footwear at the entrance.

Gym Location: Inside the main entrance, the gym will be to the right on the West side of the school.

Floor: Wood floor

Sport Specific Equipment Location and details:

Posts: There are 2 brand new green and yellow posts and two older blue posts. All four have bases. One set to one court. The other set goes to the second court.

Post Holes: For the two outside posts, use the post holes located 3 feet from the court line. For the middle post, use the post hole in the middle of the gym.

Nets: The School owns the nets. They are located in the equipment room, hanging up on the side wall. Please ensure they are put back up on the wall hooks at the end of the night. There is one net labelled "STAGE" that must be used on the court closest to the stage.

Court Lines: 2 courts with green lines all around. The end lines on both courts are very tight to the wall. For serving, just stand close to the wall (no line infractions).



Gym Set-up

Volleyball

Step 1: For setup, choose 1 post with a solid base that cranks on top, and 1 post with a solid base that cranks on the bottom. For the third post in the setup, choose a post with no solid base that has 2 cranks.

Step 2: Place each of the three posts in the correct post hole (2 posts with base at either end, post holes 3 feet outside of court lines; middle post goes in the post hole in the middle of the gym).

Step 3: For each court, ensure the end post and middle post have one high crank and low crank.

Step 4: Attach loops and carabiners on all 4 corners for both nets.

Step 5: Tighten the nets. DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN
