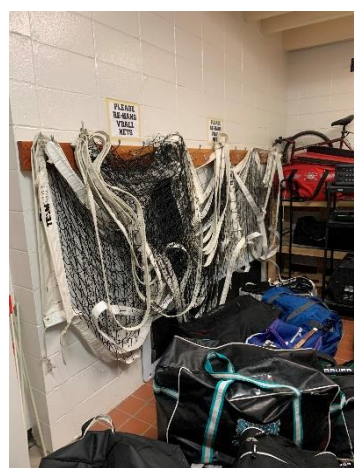

General Information

Parking: Players may park in the staff parking lot on the north side of the school.

Entrance: Caretakers prefer players use the door on the SW side of the school which will lead straight to the gym and will be unlocked prior to permit time.

Gym Location: The gym is located at the south end of the school.

Change room/Washroom: Straight ahead in the gym hallway

Equipment

Sport Specific Equipment Location and details: The school owns the posts and the nets. The posts will be in the main equipment room. The nets will be in the small equipment room in the middle of the left wall (as you enter the gym).

Posts: There are 4 royal blue posts with ropes and S-hooks stored in the equipment room, just to the left when you walk in. It is very important that these standards are put back properly at the end of the night. Follow the signage that the school has posted.

Post Holes: Use the holes closest to the court lines. They are ~3 feet from edge of the court.

Nets: The school owns the nets. They are hanging on the wall on in the smaller storage room. Use the 2 nets labeled 'SCORE V755' with cable tops and bottoms. If the nets are not labelled, ensure you grab the 2 nets with cable tops and bottoms. It is very important that these nets are hung back up properly on the wall to avoid damage! These are the schools nets and need to be treated with respect.

Court Lines: There are 2 courts. The lines are yellow all around.

Step 1: Choose one post that cranks the net on the bottom and one that cranks the net on the top for each court.

Step 2: The net height is adjustable on each post – set it to the 2nd hole from the top.

Step 3: Each net has a cable loop on all 4 corners. Attach the top of one corner of the net to the s-hook on the top of the post and the other top corner to the S-hook on the rope.

Step 4: Repeat for the bottom of the net, but the rope and crank will be on the opposite side.

Step 5: Tighten the net on the top and bottom using the crank wheel. Do NOT over-tighten.
