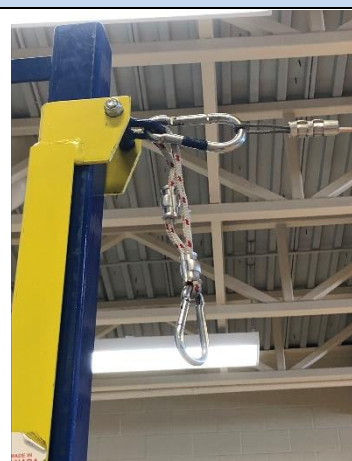

General Information

Parking: Players may **NOT** park in any reserved parking stall **AT ANY TIME**. Players can park in the staff lot on the South side of the school. There is also street parking available if the lot is full.

Entrance: Players should enter from the main entrance on the South side of the building. Players should leave outdoor footwear at the entrance.

Gym Location: Inside the main entrance, the gym will be located to the right at the front of the school.

Change room/Washroom: The washrooms are located right outside the gym entrance. Players are to use these washrooms and should not wander the halls.

Floor: Wood floor

Equipment

Sport Specific Equipment Location and details:

Posts: 4 Posts are located in the equipment room within the gym. There are holes in the floor right by the equipment room entrance where the posts should be stored. All 4 posts have adjustable yellow metal sleeves for height (set to 243 for height adjustment – use the closest pin hole on the post). 2 posts have black straps that will crank to the top, while the other 2 posts have black straps that will crank to the bottom of the net. All straps/attachments have carabiners.

Post Holes: Post holes are located ~3 feet outside of the court line.

Nets: Nets belong to the school. They are located in the equipment room within the gym and are kept on a mobile stand. Please ensure the nets are put back on this stand neatly at the end of the night. Both nets have metal loops on all 4 corners; there is also a “T” or “Top” on both nets to indicate orientation of the net during setup.

Court Lines: Red all around

Gym Set-up

Volleyball

Step 1: For each court, choose a post that cranks high and a post that cranks low.

Step 2: Place posts into the post holes located 3 feet outside of the court lines.

Step 3: Attach the top corner of the net to the top carabiner on either side.

Step 4: Attach the bottom corner of the net to the bottom carabiner on either side.

Step 5: Use the crank to tighten the top and bottom of each net. **DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN THE NETS.**

Important Notes

- Please do not let players wander the halls. The gym and washrooms are both located right at the front of the school so there is no need to wander.
- **Past Complaint:** Equipment was not put back in the proper place at the end of the night. The Volleyball nets must be hung back up on the racks at the end of the night. Ask the caretaker for assistance if needed.
- **DO NOT** use the school's Volleyballs. Use only the balls provided in the EC equipment pack.
- **Past Complaint:** Players arrived late and when let in by facility staff were rude and disrespectful. The doors at this facility will be locked 15 minutes after the permit start time. Players arriving late should contact teammates to be let in. Please **DO NOT** prop doors at this facility and be respectful of the staff.

Staff Visits:

- March 5th, 2018:
BC visited the school as players reported that the net was saggy and bottom cable on one of the nets snapped. They claimed to have used a bungee cord to one of the posts in order to make it work properly. BC assessed all of the equipment (posts, nets, attachments, carabiners) and could not find any issues. BC set up the courts as well to test it out. Everything worked fine. Good to go.
- January 15th, 2019 MS visited the school. Quick visit as everything looks good to go!
