## General Information

**Parking:** Players may park in the south parking lot, closest to the soccer fields.

**Entrance:** Enter through South doors nearest to the parking lot on the south side of the school. Go down the loading dock drive way and to the left is a set of double doors with glass windows.

**Gym Location:** Once inside, the gym is down the hall and to your left.

*The EC MUST sign in with the caretaker and needs the permit number on hand.*

**Change room/Washroom:** As you enter the school they are located immediately on the left. They are also accessible from within the gym

**Floor:** Hardwood

## Equipment

**Sport Specific Equipment Location and details:** Volleyball poles should be kept outside the gym in holders. There are 6 total but teams will only need 4. **Ensure to use the BLUE poles that are labelled for the North and South courts.** Pick 2 poles that have cranks on the top and 2 that have cranks on the bottom. Teams will need one for each court. Nets are in the *small* gym hanging on the wall. You have to walk through the large gym to get to the small gym. If door to small gym is locked, find a custodian. **You may also need to use the provided carabiners (as some of the poles need the chain to be shortened which can be done with the carabiners).**

## Gym Set-up

**Volleyball / Badminton:**

The spectator stands need to be collapsed to use the gymnasium. If they are out find a custodian to close them.



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**Step 1:** Take the blue poles from the hallway and bring them into the large gym. Insert the posts into the slots for the posts and adjust the height of the posts

**Step 2:** Retrieve the nets from the wall in the small gym (can be accessed from large gym). Set up as usual.

**Step 3:** There are 4 posts: 2 tighten the bottom and 2 tighten at the top. There should be one of each for each court. Attach nets to the poles using clips.

**Step 4:** Use the crank handle to tighten the top and bottom of the nets. Do not over tighten.
