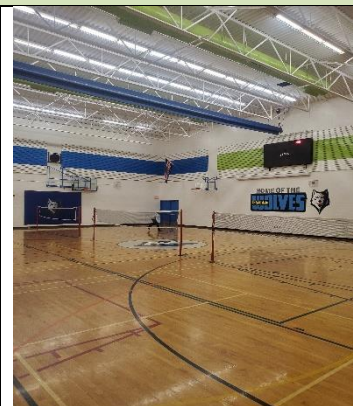

Badminton Setup

## General Information

**Parking:** Players may **NOT** park in any reserved parking stall **AT ANY TIME**. Players can park in the school lot on the East off 80 St or on the road in front of the school.

**Entrance:** Players should enter from the main entrance on the Southeast side of the building. Players should leave outdoor footwear at the entrance.

**Gym Location:** Inside the entrance the gym is on the left through the atrium.

**Changeroom/Washroom:** Players can change in the washrooms that are located outside the gym just before the entrance.

**Floor:** The gym has an older floor, if the gym is dusty please use the micro-fibre broom from the storage room. Use blue lines for volleyball, black for basketball, and white for badminton.

## Equipment

**Sport Specific Equipment Location and details:** The volleyball posts are located in the storage room on the North side of the gym. The nets are stored in the small gym which has an entrance from the main storage room. There are 6 red badminton poles stored in storage room and the nets are in a drawer labeled "Badminton Nets".

## Gym Set-up

### Volleyball

**Step 1:** Take a blue pair of posts to set up for one court and the red set of posts for the other court. The red posts should be setup to have the pin at the Sr. Men height. On the blue posts use the highest hole.

**Step 2:** Have the cranks for the top rope on the outer post holes.

**Step 3:** Ensure the rope is threaded through the pulley before clipping the net.

**Step 4:** The net with the wires attached on one side is for the blue posts.

**Step 5:** Once the nets are attached use the cranks to tighten the ropes.

### Badminton

**Step 1:** Take a pair of red posts and inset them into the holes on either side of the white badminton lines.

**Step 2:** Attach the top of the net to the rings on the top of the poles. Do the same for the bottom.

**Step 3:** Repeat for each court.

### Basketball



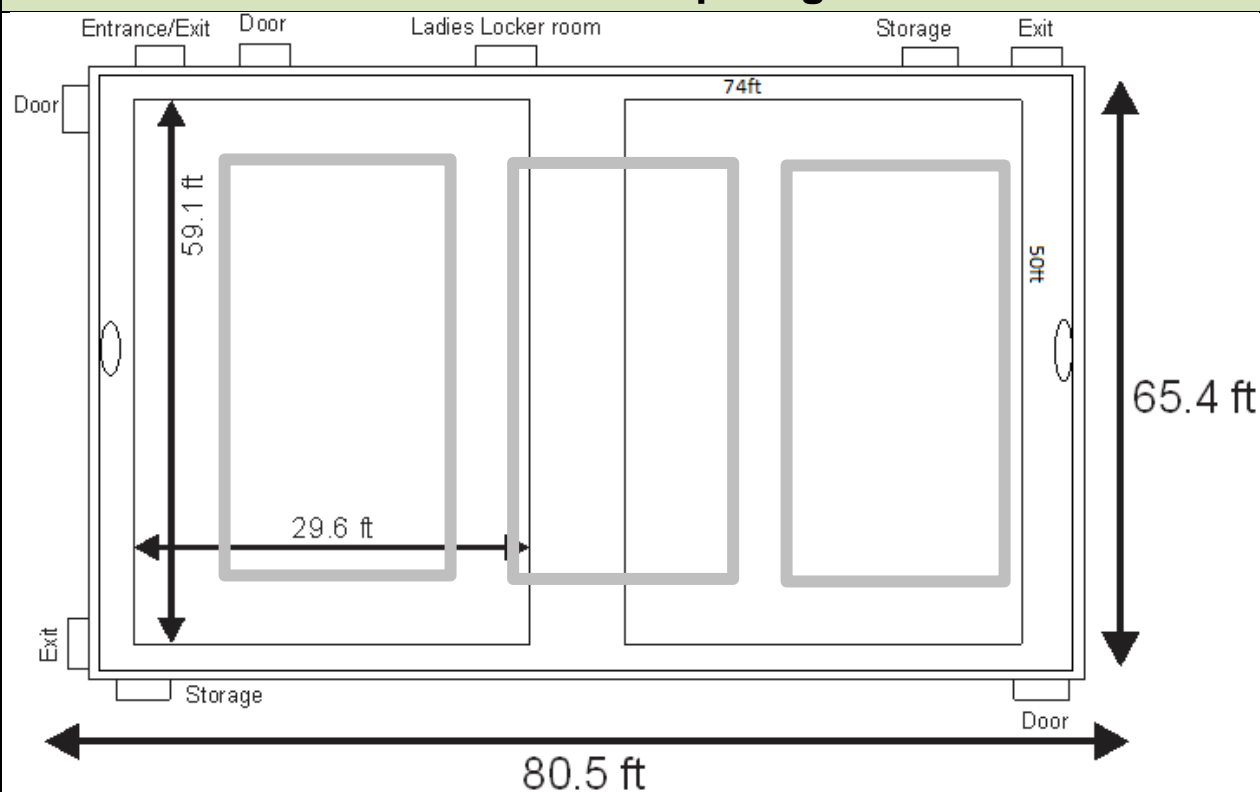

**Court Lines:** The basketball hoops can be lowered by the custodian. All of the side nets should be pulled to the side to not overhang the main court. When GC'ing use the black boundary lines.

**Player Benches:** The players can use the benches on the side of the gym, these should be kept out of the field of play.

This gym has regulation glass backboards and a break away rim. There is a 3pt line.

## Important Notes

**May 2017 – Player grabbed basketball rim and broke off hoop. ESSC had to pay facility damages.**

When putting away the posts, use the chain to wrap around posts and lock so they do not fall over and they are secure. Players must enter and exit through main doors. Custodian puts a chain up to parking at 10:30 pm on Thursday's and 11:00 pm the rest of the week.

When putting away the nets, ensure they are hanging neatly along the wall in the small gym.
