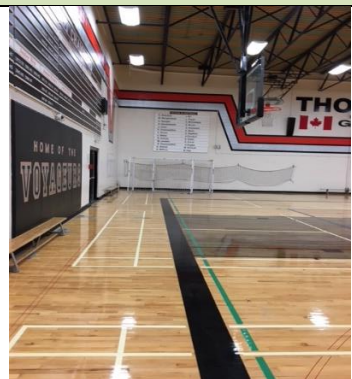

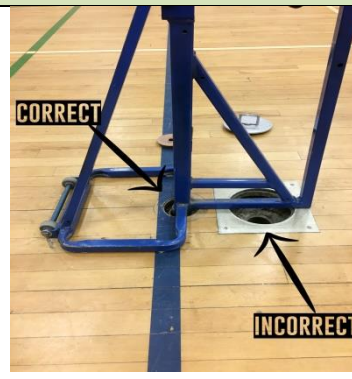

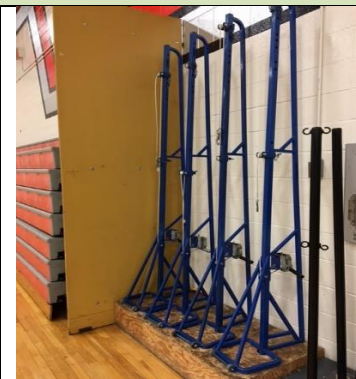
Taken from East wall

General Information

Parking: Parking is available in the lot on the North/West side of the school which can only be accessed via 66 St. You can park in this lot EXCEPT in spots that say 24hour Reserved.

Entrance: The entrance is connected to the North/West parking lot on the North side of the school. Players should leave outdoor footwear at the entrance.

Gym Location: Inside the entrance the gym is straight ahead and on the right hand side.

Changeroom/Washroom: Players can change in the washrooms that are located inside the gym, the males is on the North-West side and the females is on the North-East side.

Floor: The floors are hardwood with green court lines for volleyball and black for basketball.

Equipment

Sport Specific Equipment Location and details: The volleyball nets and posts are located on the South gym wall with the school crest. The posts are in a stand on the North wall, by the women's change room. The posts are a little worn but they are still decent. Ensure you have one post with a pulley on the top and one post with the pulley on the bottom per court. For height, use the highest holes on each of the posts.

Gym Set-up

Volleyball

Step 1: Choose one post with a pulley on the bottom and one post with a pulley on the top. Place into the small holes on opposite sides of each court.

Step 2: The net height is adjustable on each post with a pin – **use the highest hole on each of the posts** by pulling out the pin, sliding the sleeve and replacing the pin.

Step 3: Thread the rope from each pulley over the pulley and attach to the loops on the end of the net. For the post with the pulley on top, there is a 1ft wire attached to the bottom post loop that carabiners onto the bottom of the net. Attach net to opposite post by threading rope over the bottom pulley and looping onto the net. The top of the next will carabiner to the top post loop.

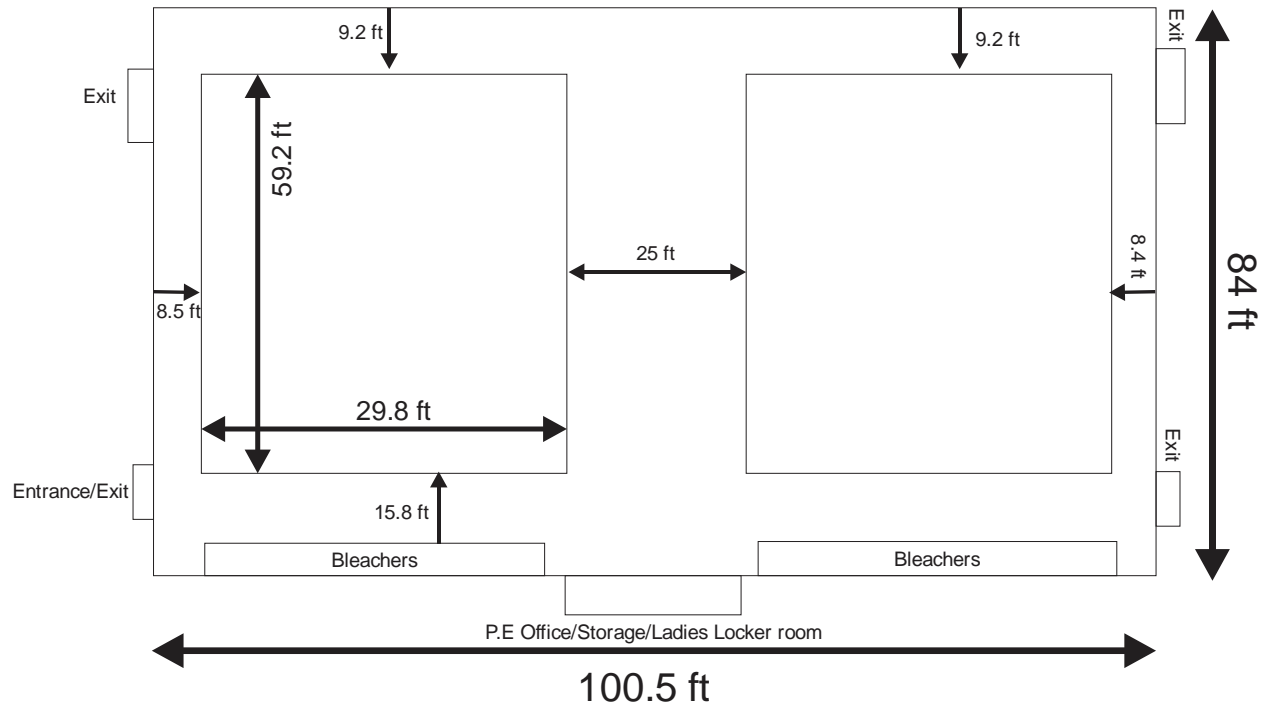
Step 4: Tighten the net on the top of the net using the crank wheel. Do NOT over-tighten.

Step 5: Repeat steps 1-4 for the second court

Important Notes

Hoops can be raised electronically and are controlled by switches by the women's change rooms. **Soccer nets in gym can be moved to the centre, but must be put back to the east and west walls at the end of the rotation.** Ask custodian for antennas if needed (if EC does not have them). Night custodian's name is Mr. Ho. Phone number to reach him is 780-499-9696 (Custodian's office).

Please do not wander in the hallway.

April 2017: Large post holes were used and a post fell and made a hole in the floor. Ensure the small post holes are used. See diagram above.
